Roll by 4 August: call 132326.*

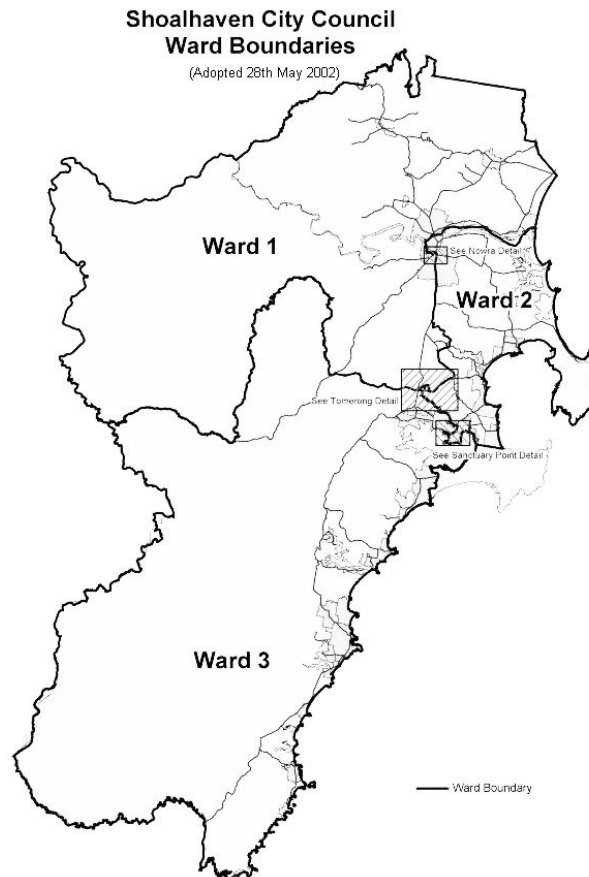
